An Environmental Product
Declaration (EPD) is an
internationally recognised
document that verifies a product's
environmental impact throughout
its entire life cycle.

It enhances credibility, supports transparent communication, and opens opportunities in tenders and export markets.

Who is it for?

Construction material manufacturer

Architects and designers prefer products with an EPD to assess a building's carbon footprint.

Export-focused companies

EPDs are often a prerequisite or clear competitive advantage in international markets and tenders.

Tender market participants

Transparency and comparable environmental data are expected in both the public and private sectors. An EPD helps deliver that.

Export

In many foreign markets, an EPD is a prerequisite for a product to be considered.

This opens doors to international tenders and purchasing decisions.



Trust

EPD report and supporting data

Standardised environmental declaration with a confidential background report.

Independent verification

Third-party confirmation of compliance with international standards.

Publication in the database

The Environmental Product Declaration is published in a database accessible to clients and partners.

Process



Data collection

We prepare the questionnaire and assist with data collection. Typically, it takes the client up to one month.

LCA calculation

We conduct the product life cycle assessment in accordance with international standards and the applicable PCR guidelines.

Independent review

A third party audits the results and confirms compliance with all requirements.

EPD publication

The Environmental **Product Declaration is** published in a database accessible to all stakeholders.

Methodology

International standards

The EPD is prepared in accordance with the following environmental management and declaration standards:

- EN 15804+A2:2019
- ISO 14025
- ISO 14040 / 14044
- ISO 21930 (where applicable, for construction products)

Product Category Rule (PCR)

Each EPD is based on a product category rule (PCR) that defines how the LCA should be conducted for the specific product category.

Interpreting results
